



Exports to Europe via UK Landbridge post Brexit

Although the final shape and timing of Brexit is still uncertain we have summarised below the information we will need for shipments transported via the UK Landbridge if the UK leaves the EU without a transitional agreement. This is because a transit document will need to be completed.

- Packages, Gross Weight and Net Weight
- Country of Origin

The goods invoice accompanying the goods must contain a declaration stating that the goods are in Free Circulation. This declaration must be signed by a person authorised to do so.

An export transit document will need to be lodged by us at least 2 hours before the vehicle departure from our depot so it will be important for us to receive this information at or prior to time of collection.
